The cost of the trip is \$180 for choristers and \$155 for chaperones. This is one of the favorite traditions in the RVCC and we're looking forward to another great trip! We'll need lots of chaperones and hope that you can join us!

Parking at Rehearsals

A/B and B+ Choirs: Please park in the lot across the street from the church. The crossing guard will help you cross the street. Enter the church through the front double doors that lead to the sanctuary.

At the end of A/B rehearsals at 5:30 and B+ rehearsal at 6:30, parent volunteers will walk the choristers across the street to the parking lot for parent pick-up.

C Choir: Please park in the lot between the church and activities building or on the street around the church. (not in the parking lot across from the church) We will not have a crossing guard during C Choir rehearsal times so please do not cross the street. There is street parking available all around the block of the church.

Everyone should enter the church through the double doors in the front of the church.

Auditions for C Choir

Thursday, February 13, 2020

Auditions for C Choir will be held on Thursday, February 13, from 4:00-6:00 in the choir room At Bethel Baptist Church. Please sign up in groups of 4 on February 3 and 10 and remember your audition time!

About 20 singers will be accepted into the C Choir based on the scores from auditions. Decisions will be based on the following:

- 1. Theory Test score given during choir on February 3.
- 2. Maturity demonstrated during rehearsals.
- 3. Musicianship and Singing ability
 - a. Sight Singing
 - b. Clapping a Rhythm
 - c. Sing Legato
 - d. Excerpts from B+ songs; **Alleluia, Psalm 23, Tengo.** You will be expected to be able to hold your part while another person sings the other part.

Eligibility: Choristers must be at least 12 years old to audition. The C choir is mostly 13-18 year old with many years of choir experience. Most choristers enter the C Choir in their 8th or 9th grade year.

*There has only been one year in recent years that everyone who tried out for C choir made it. I make the choice based on the accumulative score from your audition and available openings in certain sections. This year we have 23 graduating seniors. 4 Soprano I's, 7 Soprano II's, and 7 Alto I's, and 5 Alto II's.

Please prepare **16-32 bars of a strong actable song** for your audition. You must bring sheet music with you. No recorded accompaniment will be allowed. *Dear Evan Hansen* is a story with a very strong acting emphasis. Please choose a song to sing that will show off your acting skills and your ability to portray a strong-willed, passionate individual.

Music must be memorized!

If cast, you MUST attend *all* rehearsals, which will be:

Friday, March 27th from 6:30-8:30pm in the Fellowship Hall at Bethel Baptist Church Saturday, March 28th from 10am-3pm in the Fellowship Hall at Bethel Baptist Church Saturday, April 25th Dress Rehearsal at Jefferson Center Sunday, April 26th Performances at Jefferson Center

(You will not be called to rehearsal the entire time, but we will need you to commit to the entire block of rehearsals *before* auditioning so that we may consider you. Thank you!)
